



JUDGE RYAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Judge Ryan Memorial Scholarship was established by EAA Chapter#114 in memory of Judge Ryan Johanningsmeier. The scholarship will provide funding for aspiring pilots and current pilots who are passionate about flying yet are financially limited in their ability to receive training. The goal of the scholarship is to promote aviation through our local flying club by making it accessible to those who might not otherwise have an opportunity to experience the joy of flight. Judge Johanningsmeier's passion for flying will continue to endure through future generations of pilots.

The primary goal of the scholarship is to assist applicants in their attainment of their pilot license. The scholarship is a dollar for dollar match up to \$2,500.00.

SCHOLARSHIP OUTLINE AND REQUIREMENTS

The scholarship will be represented through EAA Chapter #114, a 501c3 organization. This will allow those who donate to the Judge Ryan Memorial Scholarship to receive a charitable donation tax benefit. The account will be managed by the EAA chapter financial officer. The scholarship fund will be established in the format of an unrestricted endowment. The goal is to use only the accrued capital gains which will establish the amount of funds available each year. In the event our financial officer (current or future) is unable to personally manage the endowment, a professional accounting service will be utilized.

To ensure scholarship funds are used for the sole purpose of flying education, the scholarship recipient will not receive funds directly. Funds will be dispersed in the form of the following:

- Dollar for Dollar match up to \$2,500.00
- Flight training must take place in one of the club aircrafts
